

Behaviour Consultant Pathways

Request for Children's Services/Referral received

- Parental consents for program visits and Ages and Stages Questionnaire

Behaviour Consultant (with parental consent) arranges visit with program within 2 weeks.

- Review documentation, observe, discussions with staff
- Provide strategies
- Up to 3 visits
- May connect Child Care Supervisor to call ECCDC for QCCN program support visits

- Level of Service Determined
- Memorandum of Understanding/Service Agreement
- Goal Plan developed

Monitor

- 1) Behaviour Consultant to link Child Care Supervisor to ECCDC QCCN Coordinator for program support visits
- 2) Behaviour Consultant will confirm with QCCN Coordinator the recommendation
- 3) Strategies provided
- 4) Follow up with child care monthly by phone or centre visit (if required) for 3 months
- 5) Discharge after 3 months, unless child shifts to Consult

Consult

- 1) Behaviour Consultant visits program one to two times per month
- 2) May link Child Care Supervisor to ECCDC QCCN Coordinator for program support visits
- 3) May link parent to other resources, e.g. Niagara Children's Centre for Occupational Therapy (sensory issues)
- 4) Strategies/Goals provided
- 5) Transition to school process/planning
- 6) Transition to before/after school child care if new to program

Full Service

- 1) Behaviour Consultant visits program weekly/bi-weekly depending on attendance
- 2) Facilitate referral through Contact Niagara for assessment/treatment
- 3) Behaviour Consultant will transition to school and/or will continue to support child in licensed child care (consideration given for extenuating circumstances)
- 4) Transition to before/after school child care if new to program
