43. Every operator shall ensure that where special dietary and feeding arrangements have been made with the operator with respect to a child enrolled in a day nursery operated by the operator or in a location where private-home day care is provided by the operator that the arrangements are carried out in accordance with the written instructions of a parent of the child.

INTENT

Where an operator agrees to accept a child who needs special foods and/or feeding arrangements at mealtime, expectations of parent and operator must be clear.

INDICATORS

Indicator Type: Interview

1. The supervisor states whether or not there is a special diet or feeding arrangement for any child(ren) enrolled.

Indicator Type: Documentation

1. For any child identified as having a special feeding or dietary arrangement, specific instructions between a parent of the child and the operator of the day nursery are found in the child's records.

Indicator Type: Physical Inspection

1. Instructions are observed to be complied with for any child whose records contain written instructions regarding special dietary or feeding arrangements.
