Act It Out: kits include materials for involving children in dramatic play & other role-playing activities.

Active Play Equipment: a variety of physical activity & movement materials to support the development of children's large and small muscles.

Animal Friends: kits are geared to helping children develop a greater understanding of animals such as rabbits, pets, etc.


Building, Technology & Block Center Materials: a variety of materials to help enhance your building and/or block center.

Culture, Customs & Special Occasions: this collection contains materials to help children learn more about various customs, holidays, and traditions.

Everybody is An Artist: kits contain ideas and materials for visual art activities such as painting, drawing, sculpture, and cutting and pasting.

Everyday Places and the People We Know: designed to help children learn more about the places they've been or are likely to go and to recognize and understand people, careers, and relationships.

Getting Along with Others: this collection is geared to helping children develop emotional, behavioural, and social skills.



Help for Early Learning and Care Providers: collection to help early learning & care providers approach various scenarios with confidence and professionalism (i.e. helping children cope with divorce) and to provide supervisors materials for training/coaching their staff teams.

Incredible Insects: kits are geared to helping children develop a greater understanding of insects such as bees and butterflies.

Infant Activity Equipment: a variety of equipment which strengthens the development of infants and toddlers and promotes their sense of wonder and curiosity.

Mastering Math Collection: materials to help children develop an understanding of math concepts such as number sense and numeration, measurement, geometry and spatial sense, patterning, data management, and probability.

Science Concepts & Natural Wonders: designed for introducing basic concepts such as colours, shapes, parts of the body, and magnets; and for helping children learn more about physical science, life science, earth, and the environment.

Stories, Poems & Songs: this collection is useful for helping children develop language & listening skills - activities related to nursery rhymes, fairy and folk tales, and props for storytelling are included.

Taking Care of Myself: this collection deals with topics related to personal care, healthy habits, well-being, and safety.
