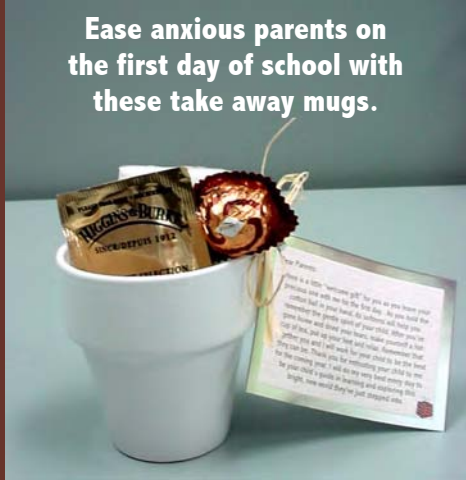

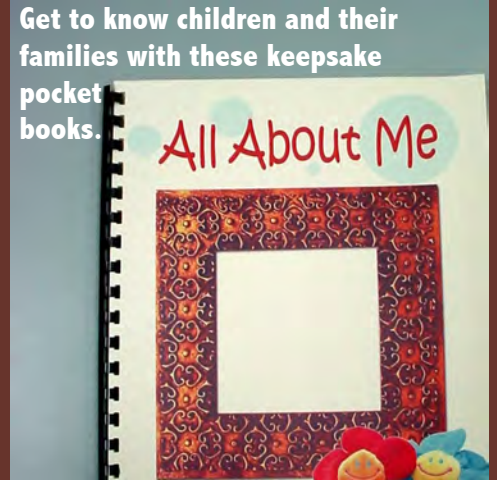
Comfort children experiencing separation anxiety with these welcome bags.

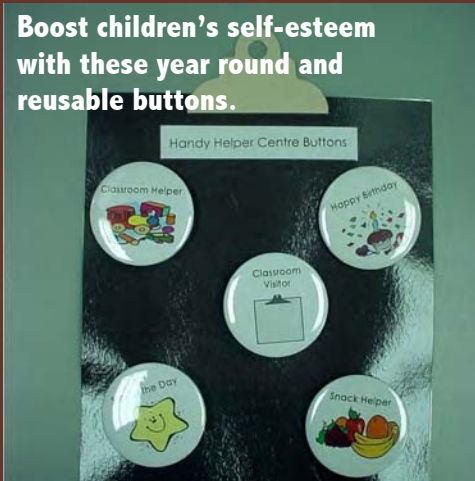


Ease anxious parents on the first day of school with these take away mugs.
