DISC Preschool Screen (DPS)

Reminder of Days calculation if score under days column is 15 and under record 0 months but if score is 16 and over record 1 month.

“How can we acknowledge, respect and value family’s diverse identities and needs when having the conversation?”

Behaviour C.A.R.E. Checklist

All behaviour is a form of communication

Documenting the frequency, intensity, duration, and severity

Communicate with the child’s family/guardian throughout the whole process

“When can the checklist be used?”

Speech and Language Referral Checklist

Complete the checklist annually

Remember that the checklist asks about how the child is communicating with you (the educator)

Choose the age category the child has most recently reached

“What strategies can we use in sharing information with families?”

Environmental Supports

Environmental Rating Scales (ITERS-3 and ECERS-3)

Environmental Rating Scales Feedback Form

Resource and Inventory Lists

“How many times a year do we do the Environmental Rating Scales?”

Scoring rules of Thumb:

If less than $\frac{1}{2}$ the indicators in a column are scored YES, the score is that of the previous column

If *at least* $\frac{1}{2}$, but not all of the indicators in a column are scored YES, the score is the next lowest number (2, 4, or 6).

Scoring Ranges can be found on Page 9 of the ECERS-3

Program Profile

Program profiles can be completed monthly, twice a year or once a year

Can be completed individually or as part of a team

Used in alignment with How Does Learning Happen? Reflecting on the three teachers

“Why reflective programming important?”

“How can we measure how staff have evolved and grown over the year in their practice?”

Strategies to Develop Family Engagement

“How can I continue those great interactions with families during this time?”
