## **Kiwaniis Sponsorship Will Support Niagara’s Early Learning Programs in Having Greater Access to Curriculum Resources, Classroom Equipment, and Organizational Supports**

The Early Childhood Community Development (ECCDC) is grateful to be the recipient of a four-year financial commitment of close to \$50,000 from the Kiwanis Clubs of Niagara. The sponsorship will increase the ECCDC’s ability to support Niagara’s early learning programs in having greater access to pedagogical materials, classroom equipment, and organizational supports through the availability of a community outreach van.

The community outreach van will be utilized to deliver resources from the ECCDC’s Resource Lending Library, located in Thorold, to over 170 licensed child care programs throughout the Niagara Region. The delivery service will make it easier and more affordable for child care centres to gain access to these unique materials for the thousands of children enrolled in their programs and will reduce mileage costs for programs, while saving staff time. With less time spent trying to access and purchase materials, educators will have more time to do the most important work of setting up nurturing and supportive environments and experiences to support the children enrolled in their programs.
