Niagara's early learning and child care sector has recently undergone many changes, and we have successfully navigated this change through the dedication and collaboration of our early learning community. This EPIC event will recognize the contributions of educators, early childhood education students and volunteers involved in Niagara's early learning, kindergarten, and child care programs for their Excellence, Professionalism, Innovation and Commitment to children and families during this special ceremony, which will be hosted by 105.7 EZ Rock's Lori Love. The ECCDC's services are available to all of Niagara's ECEs and teachers, as well as others involved in the care and education of children.
