New Dates! QCCN Training

The QCCN Reflective Practice Institute is being offered through pre-recorded webinar modules for educators supporting infant, toddler, and preschool programs who did not previously complete the QCCN Reflective Practice Institutes.

Five (5) webinar modules will be offered in two (2) rotations and educators can select to register for one of the two rotations to complete over a three-month period.
