# New! QCCN Speech and Language Webinar Training Module for Educators (mandatory)

There is a new mandatory QCCN Training that educators will be required to take sometime between **October 23, 2023** and **October 21, 2024**.

This pre-recorded webinar module is approximately an hour in length and includes training on the new Niagara Children's Centre Online Referral Portal and updated Checklists, Referral Process, and documents. *Please note*, the cut-off date for the previous Speech and Language documents (updated October 2020) will be February 28, 2023.

#### What are the criteria?

This training is *mandatory* for staff who meet **both** the following criteria;

- a) Educators currently supporting infant, toddler, and/or preschool programs in Niagara; and
- b) Educators who have completed the QCCN Reflective Practice Institute in the past (between November 2015 and August 2023).

If you answered **"Yes"** to both the questions above, then this QCCN Speech and Language Webinar Training Module is **mandatory** for you.

#### Who submits the registrations?

We ask that Supervisors register all of their team members who fit the above criteria. Registrations made by individual staff members cannot be accepted at this time.

The QCCN Reflective Practice Institute is being offered through pre-recorded webinar modules for educators supporting infant, toddler, and preschool programs who **did not** complete the QCCN Reflective Practice Institutes.
