

## **Speech and Language Referral Checklist Information Sheet**

The Speech and Language Referral Checklist is intended to help child care professionals identify children who may benefit from an assessment of their communication development by a Speech-Language Pathologist. To find out more information check out the Niagara Children's Centre Speech and Language Referral Checklist Overview & Instructions for QCCN.

- Parent/guardian consent forms are signed on an annual basis; parent/guardian signature is also obtained to verify that results have been discussed with them after the screen has been completed.
- If a child is already known to Niagara Children's Centre, you do not need to complete a Speech and Language Referral Checklist
- Use the newest consent form in English (February 2021), <u>PDF</u> (print and fill out by hand) or <u>Fillable PDF</u> (fill out on your computer).
- Use the newest consent form in French (February 2021), <u>PDF</u> (print and fill out by hand) or <u>Fillable PDF</u> (fill out on your computer).
- The Checklist is divided into 10 age categories: 6 months, 9 months, 12 months, 15 months, 18 months, 2 years, 2.5 years, 3 years, 3.5 years and 4 years. Complete ONE age category per child: choose the category that the child has most recently reached. The Checklists are also available in French and can be found on the QCCN Website.
- Remember that the Checklist asks how the child is communicating with you (the educator).
- The Checklist should be completed by thinking about the child's skills in the language they know best.
- Use the <u>Speech and Language Referral Checklist Tracking Sheet</u> or <u>DPS and Speech and Language Referral Checklist</u>
   <u>Tracking Sheet</u> to track information, ensuring no children are missed. *Note* the "how to score the checklist" section is also on the checklist itself.
- <u>Niagara Children's Centre Speech and Language Referral Pathways for QCCN</u> has further information for referrals
  and includes the reminder that all children must be referred by August 31 prior to starting year one kindergarten. It is
  also available in <u>French</u>.
- Use the newest Niagara Children's Centre Speech and Language Referral Form for QCCN and in French.
- Stats are to be submitted by the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month for the month prior through a link sent by Niagara Region. Or you can visit **QCCN Monthly Reporting**. The link is on the right-hand side under Reporting. **Reminder**: scores and referrals are reported within the same month on stats form.
